

# PALM SUNDAY! -

## "THE TRIUMPHAL ENTRY!"

### NO. 1

At Bethany on the Mount of Olives outside the City of Jerusalem, the Disciples borrowed a donkey colt that had never been ridden. They placed their cloaks on the donkey and Jesus sat upon it. This was spoken about by the prophet Zechariah almost 500 years before it happened.

### NO. 2

The people came out to honor Jesus as Messiah and King. They laid palm branches and their cloaks on the roadway as a sign of welcoming royalty. A practice that was done in those days

### NO. 3

They said words like, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

### NO. 4

The people thought Jesus was coming to rule politically and overthrow the harsh Roman government, save them and establish peace. But Jesus came to save them from their sins, to set them free spiritually and give inner peace.

### NO. 5

The people turned on Jesus once they realized He wasn't going to save them from the Romans. A week after entering Jerusalem, the people shouted, "Crucify him!" and Jesus died on a cross.

### NO. 6

Prayer for you: To understand Jesus came to save us from our sins, gives us inner peace in our hearts and that one day He will come back.

### NO. 7

Next week we will learn more about Jesus's death and the great victory that took place.
