THE PASSION WEEK STORY & EASTER SUNDAY! "RESURRECTION SUNDAY"!!!

- 1. The Triumphal Entry Palm Sunday
- 2. Jesus clears the Temple, upsets the Pharisees.
- 3. Jesus teaches on the Mount of Olives.
- 4. Jesus observes the Passover and establishes the Lord's Supper.
- 5. Jesus prays in the Garden of Gethsemane.
- 6. Jesus is betrayed by Judas and is arrested.
- 7. Jesus is taken to several sham trials before the chief priests, Pontius Pilate and Herod.
- 8. Jesus is beaten by Roman soldiers and forced to carry a cross through Jerusalem.
- 9. Jesus is nailed to the cross at Golgotha and dies.
- 10. Jesus is buried in a tomb and a large stone covers the entrance to the tomb.
- 11. On Sunday morning, Jesus rises from the dead.
- 12. Many people discover the empty tomb; many others see and meet Jesus face to face.

The Resurrection . . . does it matter? Luke 24

(Luke 24:1-12)

- The disciples never understood when Jesus spoke about His death and resurrection.
- You see, the resurrection DOES matter because:
- It vindicates His Word.

(Luke 24:6-8)

- If He did not rise again, then everything else He taught them would be in doubt because His resurrection was at the core of His teaching. (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)
- To convince the disciples, He didn't show them His SCARS, He showed them the SCRIPTURES!
- II. It validates His Work!

- The cross of Chris is the payment of our debt and the resurrection is God's receipt for the exact amount!

- 3. Comforting power (1 Thessalonians 4:14 & 18)
- 4. Conquering power (Philippians 3:10)
- 5. Convicting power (Acts 17:3)
