- Last time we thought about the dangers, description (his character, conduct and creed) and destruction of the apostate. Today we will look at what he does . . .

(Jude 8)

(Deuteronomy 13:1-5)

- according to verse 8

I. They \_\_\_\_\_ the flesh

- An apostate will be more wicked and more vile than a mere unbeliever.  
(II Peter 2:19-22)

II. They \_\_\_\_\_ the Father – “reject authority”

- What is this speaking of? (Jude 25) the Father above is both dominion and authority!
- An apostate may be religious and talk about God but he does not want a God who rules.

III. They \_\_\_\_\_ the faithful – “revile angelic majesties”

- 2 verses later Jude will point out that they revile things they don't understand, like an unreasoning animal.
- That is, they speak lightly, irreverently, flippantly about \_\_\_\_\_ things.
- Jude illustrates the point in (v. 9)
- Michael, the glorious archangel showed more respect to \_\_\_\_\_ than some people show to Almighty God!
