(Jude 24, 25)

- Last week we saw that our hope is rooted in 3 things:

- I. The Sovereignty of the Savior
- II. The Security of the Saved
- III. The Sufficiency of Salvation

- Today we will expand point three by examining the phrase “... *make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy,*” (v.24)
- I personally believe this alludes to the time of the rapture – the time when Jesus (the bridegroom) comes back for His bride (the church). The analogy of comparing the bridegroom/bride to Jesus/church is found often in the New Testament.
