(John 7:37-39)

(Acts 1:8)

- A normal Christian is not one who is just having his needs met . . . a normal Christian is someone who is meeting the needs of others.

I. The Source of the River (v. 1)

A. Comes out of the Temple *“door of the house”*

(1 Corinthians 6:19)

B. Flows past the altar *“from south of the altar”*

- What is a *“cross”*? A great bit *“I”* crossed out!

(Luke 9:23)

II. The Course of the River (Ezekiel 47:2-6)

- It flows in:

A. Deep Places (v. 5)

- He is talking about the ever deepening work of God in our lives.

B. Desert Places (Ezekiel 47:8)

C. Depressed Places (v. 8) *“toward the sea”*
