- The name "Samson" means "sunshine".
- One of the saddest stories in the Bible is the story of how Samson went from disobedience to defeat to disgrace to disappointment and finally to destruction.

- 1. The \_\_\_\_\_ force of Sin (Judges 16:18-21)
- Note this: the deeper one goes into sin, the less he understands about sin!
