Christmas Toy Store Ministry

The Central Family blessed the community with love, prayers, gifts and service this past Christmas Season The 2020 Christmas Toy Store served 213 families and provided for 466 children. Each child received three toys, one plush item, a container of candy, a Christ centered book; each family received one roll of wrapping paper, tape, bows, handmade gift tags, a tin of cookies, box of candy canes, several stocking stuffers, *The Christmas Promise Devotional* Book, a letter from CBC and CBC brochure, *PEACE with God* tract from the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association, PEACE handmade Scripture card, and a \$40.00 Food Voucher to Save a Lot. Central has operated a free Christmas Toy Store since 1995. The year 2020 was the 26th Toy Store. Money and gifts are not included in Central's Annual Church Budget, but the Central family gives freely during the *"Christmas in July"* emphasizing the Christmas Toy Store Ministry. Over \$32,000.00 was given by members of Central and the Christmas Toy Store gave out \$32,000.00 worth of toys, other items and food vouchers. There were approximately 100 Volunteers involved in the Christmas Toy Store Ministry.
