### TOUGHEN UP BUTTERCUP, Part 7 "HOW TO MUZZLE THE DOUBTER" I PETER 2

I PETER 2:11-20

- If you are a Christian, it's very important how you live because someone is watching you.

*"You are writing a Gospel,  
a chapter each day  
by the things that you do  
and the words that you say.  
Men read what you write  
whether baseless or true.  
Say . . . what is the Gospel  
according to you?" author unknown*

- In verse 15 the word for "silence" (Greek "phimoō") means "to muzzle".

- 2 reasons for a lovely life:
