The Greek word used to describe hell is "Gehenna," which is taken from the valley of Hinnom, just south of Jerusalem. "This was an area outside the wall of Jerusalem where children had once been offered as burnt sacrifices to Molech (2 Chron. 28:3; 33:6), and which had become the city's incinerator area, where the garbage and the discarded corpses of those without families were daily burned." (J.I. Packer)
