 - imminent - It could happen at any moment.
 - immediate - "I come quickly"
 - immutable

(Revelation 22:11) meaning?

He is saying that decisions determine character
and that character determines destiny!

- This is why we must be saved in time because we won't
have the opportunity in eternity! (II Corinthians 6:2)
