## "Last Things"

## Revelation 22

(Revelation 22:14)

• The Lord Jesus said; "Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God." (Matthew 4:4)

We will continue in chapter 22 because these words are important!

• What robe is v.14 speaking of? (Isaiah 61:10) (Titus 3:5) (Revelation 7:13-14)

(Revelation 22:15)

- This verse contrasts verse 14. Verse 14 tells us who is going to heaven while verse 15 tells us who is not!
- It is not speaking of literal dogs. "Dogs" in the Bible is a descriptive term for that which is unholy. e.g. (Matthew 7:6) (Deuteronomy 23:18) (Philippians 3:2)

(Revelation 22:16)

- This is an interesting verse! This is the first time the word "church" is used since chapter 3.
- A careless reading of this verse would think that root and offspring means the same thing. "Root" means Kind David sprang up from me, Jesus is both the ancestor <u>and</u> descendent of David!

Now notice some last things:

I. The Last	(Revelation 22:17	)
-------------	-------------------	---

- The Spirit and all true Christians yearn for Christ to come.
- What is the qualification to come? A thirst! God satisfies thirsty ones.
- II. The Last \_\_\_\_\_ (Revelation 22:18-19)
  - We may not understand it but we better not tamper with it!
  - Some denominations believe that some parts of the Bible (like the 4 Gospels) are more inspired than others. Some parts may be more fruitful and more helpful in our lives but no less inspired.
- III. The Last \_\_\_\_\_ (Revelation 22:20)
  - How sure is the 2nd Coming? As sure as the Word of Jesus.

Why is He Coming?

- 1. Rapture the Church
- 2. Redeem and restore our fallen bodies and sinful nature
- 3. Reward us
- 4. Reign
- IV. The Last \_\_\_\_\_ (Revelation 22:21)
  - How like God to close His Book with a final reference to grace!
