B. The _____ Christ *"and be satisfied"*

- the 7 definitions of the word "satisfied"

1. when the terms of a contract have been fully met
2. when a financial obligation has been fully discharged
3. when the specifications of a blue print have been fully followed
4. when reparation has been made to an injured party
5. when something is completely adequate
6. when someone is pleased and made happy
7. when someone has been gratified to the full
