

## SERMON NOTES

### The Gospel of Isaiah

#### "The Authority of the Son" Isaiah 53:12

- When scholars saw the prophecies of the coming Messiah, some concluded there must be 2 messiahs coming. We (looking back) know now there were not 2 messiahs . . . there are 2 comings. The Messiah would come 2 times:

the first to bear the cross

the second to wear the crown.

- In the last verse of Isaiah 53 we will see that Isaiah took the two comings and merged them as though they were one.

(Isaiah 53:12)

I. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ's Authority (v. 12a)

- There is something right and fitting that the very place where He was beaten down will ultimately be the place of His triumph!
- 2 things will happen:

A. \_\_\_\_\_ the works of His \_\_\_\_\_

(Isaiah 24:21)

B. \_\_\_\_\_ the spoils with His \_\_\_\_\_

*"He shall divide the spoils of the mighty"* Septuagint

*"He will receive the mighty as spoil"* HCSB

II. The \_\_\_\_\_ for Christ's Authority (v. 12b)

A. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ's suffering

*"Because He poured out Himself to death"*

- Jesus kept back NOTHING!

B. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ's suffering

1. the indignity that Jesus bore

*"was numbered with the transgressors"*

2. the iniquity that Jesus bore

*"bore the sin of many"*

C. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ's suffering

*"interceded for the transgressors"*

- Jesus makes intercession for this world today; giving men one more opportunity to flee to Him for safety.

- What more can He do?

- What more can He say?
