## The Gospel of Isaiah "Only A Borrowed Tomb" Isaiah 53

• In our last message we followed Jesus through the trial process, beaten and "cut off" out of the land of the living. Today we will look at His burial and especially His tomb.

(Matthew 27:57-60) (John 19:38-41)

• What did Isaiah have to say about the burial of Christ some 750 years before it happened?

(Isaiah 53:9) I. The Grave the was \_\_\_\_\_ for Him by His \_\_\_\_\_ (Isaiah 53:9a) • Wicked hands produced the death of Jesus but at the point of His burial, God said "Enough" as He had prophesied. Never again would wicked hands touch Him! II. The Grave that was \_\_\_\_\_ for Him by His \_\_\_\_\_ (Isaiah 53:9b) • Notice 2 things here: 1. Divine \_\_\_\_\_ - God had prepared the hearts of 2 men that day for this desperate need. They were marked by 2 things: A. Position B. Prosperity 2. Divine - Isaiah tells us 2 reasons that the Father saw to it that He had a proper burial: A. His blameless \_\_\_\_\_ "because He had done no violence" B. His blameless \_\_\_\_\_ "nor was there any deceit in His mouth"
