The Gospel of Isaiah

"The Triumph over Death" Isaiah 53:10

• In a culture that anticipated a coming Messiah but still offered animal sacrifices, Calvary is visited again and again. We will see a different perspective of Calvary in verse 10 and then . . . the resurrection.

I. The ______ of the Cross ______ "But the LORD was pleased to crush Him, putting Him to grief; if He would render Himself as a guilt offering." (v. 10a)

- A. The Unfathomable Mystery of Calvary
 - In the Scriptures we're introduced to the "Holy of Holies", "Song of Songs", "King of Kings", and the "Lord of Lords". This is the "Mystery of Mysteries!
 - 1. God's _____ "crush Him"
 - 2. God's _____ "the Lord was pleased"
 - There were 2 types of offerings:
 - a. sin offering a constant reminder of the terrible cost of sin.
 - b. sweet savor offerings (from God's perspective)
 - Peace offering: had communion at heart
 - Meal offering: had character at heart
 - Burnt offering: had consecration at heart
- B. The Unforgettable Ministry of Calvary "If He would render Himself as a

guilt offering"

II. The Triumph of the Cross Revealed "He will see His offspring . . . in His hand" (v. 10b)

A. The Express Proof of His Holiness "He shall prolong His days"

• The resurrection proves who He is!
