• The overarching truth of authority is: You will never be over until you are under.

(I Thessalonians 2:13)

• The Bible doesn't call itself the Bible. God's favorite term for the Bible is "the Word of God". e.g.

Mark 7:13 Luke 5:1 Acts 4:31 Ephesians 6:17 Colossians 1:25 I Timothy 4:5 Hebrews 4:12 I Peter 1:23 II Peter 3:5 Revelation 20:4

- Now if this book is the Word of God, there are 3 truths that come out of it . . .
- I. Truth concerning inspiration (I Thessalonians 2:13) (II Timothy 3:16)
 - · "inspired" means "God breathed"

(II Peter 1:21)

- by inspiration we do not mean:
 - A. natural inspiration
 - B. partial inspiration
 - C. progressive inspiration
- · We believe in verbal, plenary inspiration.
 - verbal (latin "vervos" for "Word") i.e. word for word inspiration
 - plenary (latin "plenus" for "full") i.e. fully inspired
- II. Truth concerning <u>identification</u> (the Bible is not the only thing called "the Word of God")
 - Jesus is also called the Word of God (Revelation 19:13; John 1:1)

Both are said to be eternal I Peter 1:23 Revelation 1:18
Both are said to be unchanging Both are said to be light Psalm 119:103 John 8:12
Both are said to be true John 17:17 John 14:6
